Our focus on implementation and our success in producing results has involved us in a number of “first’s” in the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) process and through other federal privatization programs. These include:

First privatization-in-place effort involving operations at a military installation designated for closure under BRAC

First major commercial application producing laboratory space under the Federal Privatization Program

First Army rural, no-cost economic development conveyance (EDC)

First Army transfer of unremediated CERCLA (Superfund) property (Section 334 conveyance)

First agreements containing precedent-setting environmental standards relieving property transferees from potential environmental liabilities

First attempt to accomplish space needs by exchanging land for private construction of building space
